IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- EA offers programs in science, technology, engineering, math, arts, music, literacy, health, and nutrition, and provides homework support in all academic areas, during the Learning Zone.
- The fee for Fall term is \$40. Programming and classes are offered on a first-come, first-served basis. The AM program will be limited to 30 students / PM program to 100 students (including Kindergarten), for Fall term.
- Students must **CHECK IN** by 7:30am for the AM program at the **cafeteria entrance** and will not be let in the building until 7:30am. They will check in for the PM program at 3:30pm (M,T,Th,F) / 1:15pm (Wed only) by lining up outside the breezeway entrance after being released from their homeroom teachers (same as last year). **PICK UP** will be at the **west side entrance by the SKEF office** every day (same as last year). Please do **NOT** pick-up/drop-off at the front of the school/Main Office.
- Students must wear a wristband at all times while participating in the program (provided).
- Students are to be picked up/walk home/go to Boys and Girls Club no later than 05:40pm (Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri) and 3:25pm (Wed).
- USDA suppers will be provided for participants under the age of 18. We are an equal opportunity institution.
- Students engaging in inappropriate behavior may be sent home or removed from program at staff discretion.
